



## Tournament Information

**NOMADS South African Juniors International**

**March 2nd – 5th 2020**

## **1.0 Schedule and Format**

This 54 hole individual championship takes place at the Rondebosch Golf Club (for course information visit <http://www.rondeboschgolfclub.com>). There are 18 holes played per day – morning only. The NOMADS SAJI is held from 3 - 5 March 2020. Official practice round is on March 2nd 2020.

## **2.0 International Team Competition**

An *International Team Competition* will be held simultaneously over the first 36 holes played. A team consists of three players of the same nationality, nominated by a National Federation (or an equivalent body). A team can be made up of both boys and girls. Countries can enter more than one team. The team score will be the aggregate score of the best two players' scores for rounds 1 and 2 only. The winner will be the team recording the lowest aggregate scores.

## **3.0 Eligibility to play**

This event is co-sanctioned between the GJG Tour and 21golffleague and is open to amateur golfers, both boys and girls, in the age classes:

3.1 GJG Tour players age 12-18 (max. 18 at the start of the event – March 4th 2020)

3.2 21golffleague age 19-21 (max. 21 at the start of the event)

- > All players need to become a GJG Tour member or 21golffleague member
- > All players must be members of a registered golf club
- > Handicap limit: Boys 5 / Girls 7 (for South African players: HCP Index Boys 2 / Girls 5)

*If a player does not meet the HCP limits or has no GJG eligibility status, please send a wildcard inquiry to [service@globaljuniorgolf.com](mailto:service@globaljuniorgolf.com) with latest tournaments results. The tournament committee has 10 wildcards available.*

## **4.0 Field Size**

The tournament is open for a maximum of 120 participants (minimum 45 spots are reserved for internationals). The tournament committee reserves the right to change/limit the size of the field. One third of the field will be designated for girls. If the field is limited, the tournament committee shall apply the following guidelines in determining which entries shall be accepted:

- 4.1 Handicap;
- 4.2 National event finishes;
- 4.3 International and National Ranking Systems;
- 4.4 Tournament Committee Invitations.

## **5.0 Entry: Closing Date and Procedures**

### **5.1 International Players**

Entries close on February 8th 2020 and confirmation is given out by first come first serve.

All international players must be or become a member of the Global Junior Golf on the terms and conditions as determined by the GJG. International entries register directly on the <https://www.globaljuniorgolf.com/register/> web site.

*International players may request early confirmation of entry to help with international travel bookings directly from the organizer Pro Golf Events. A player is only accepted at the tournament, if he has paid in full the Entry Fee towards Pro Golf Events.*

## 5.2 South African Nationals

Entries close on February 10th 2020.

South African players must ONLY register on South African entry form and abide by the conditions relating to South African players only. Please read exemption criteria and the entry conditions and information for South African Nationals on the South African Nationals Entry Form.

5.3 Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the tournament committee.

> All information required in the entry form must be provided accurately and in full.

## 6.0 Prizes

On conclusion of 54 holes:

6.1 The winner of the Boys Competition will be awarded the Boys Champion Trophy. Prizes will also be awarded to the players finishing from 1st to 3rd place.

6.2 The winner of the Girls Competition will be awarded the Girls Champion Trophy. Prizes will also be awarded to the players finishing from 1st to 3rd place.

6.3 International Team Competition trophy will be awarded to winning team as well as a prize for each member of the winning team.

*It is compulsory for all players to attend prize giving which will take place immediately after completion of the final round - around 02:00 PM on March 5th 2020.*

## 7.0 Registration

Competitors must register at the designated player registration desk at Rondebosch Golf Club between the hours of 08:00 AM and 12:00 AM on Monday March 2nd 2020. Failure to register within the prescribed time period could result in the player forfeiting his or her place in the tournament unless mitigating circumstances can be proven. Registration via email ([henk@progolfevents.nl](mailto:henk@progolfevents.nl)) is possible for those who can not attend on Monday March 2nd.

## 8.0 Practice Rounds & Trolleys

The official tournament practice round is Monday March 2nd 2020. (07:30 AM to 01:00 PM) To book an official practice time please send email to [golfmanager@rgc.co.za](mailto:golfmanager@rgc.co.za). All official practice times booked will be allocated on a first come first served basis. These times are open only for players participating in the tournament. Only limited Trolleys are available and have to be booked directly at the golf course. Please send your email to: [golfmanager@rgc.co.za](mailto:golfmanager@rgc.co.za) well in advance.

## 9.0 Entry Fee

INTERNATIONALS € 155

The Entry Fee has to be paid to the organizer Pro Golf Events and includes:

- Official practice round
- Tournament rounds
- Use of the practice facilities
- Opening and closing ceremony functions and dinner on the opening ceremony
- Lunch on tournament days
- Fruit and drinks on the golf course during the tournament

SOUTH AFRICAN Players fees as per entry conditions on the SA Entry form.

## 10.0 Shuttle

Flights must be booked to Cape Town International airport. A free shuttle will be available for players needing transport from the airport to the players hotel. Airport shuttle is only available on the dates and times below. For Internationals please communicate your flight details to Pro Golf Events ([henk@progolfevents.nl](mailto:henk@progolfevents.nl)) as soon as possible but no later than January 10th!

## 11.0 Accommodation Recommendation (not mandatory)

Information by Global Junior Golf e.V. or Pro Golf Events regarding hotels or other accommodation that may be booked by a player or his legal representative during a Tournament is given for convenience purposes only. Global Junior Golf e.V. or Pro Golf Events does not act as agent of or broker for the hotel or other accommodation. Global Junior Golf e.V. or Pro Golf Events does not manage any hotel bookings regarding the tournament above.

Package option listed on a tournament info website of the designated tournament are only for convenience reasons. It is a players responsibility to manage its bookings or payments with the respective party. A shuttle service will run from the hotel to the golf course from March 2nd to 5th and the airport shuttle will run from Cape Town International Airport on Saturday February 29th and Sunday March 1st and for return on March 5th and 6th only.

Hotel accommodation must be booked directly with the recommended hotel: **Park Inn by Radisson\*\*\*\***

Cost of the hotel will be **R1500** (approx € 92,00) per room per night\*.
