COVID-19: HYGIENE PROTOCOL

General Hygiene guidelines: It is the players responsibility to follow and respect the governmental guidelines at any time while attending the tournament. Please see the following guidelines at a glance:

- i. Social distancing at any time. Stay a minimum of 1.5 meters away from any person.
- ii. Wash your hands thoroughly.
- iii. Please use your arm/elbow while sneezing or coughing.
- iv. Do not touch, shake hands or hug any other person.
- v. Make sure to pre inform yourself about regulations of the respective golf club and follow the guidelines at any time.
- vi. Wear a facemask when entering the clubhouse, pro shop or any other building of the golf course.
- vii. Do not touch your face with your hands.
- viii. Make sure to fill out an attendance document.
- ix. Book your practice round prior to attending the tournament through the golf club. Do not attend the official practice round, if you have not pre booked you practice round at the respective golf club.
- x. Please use only your own golf balls or clubs while practicing. Do not touch a ball or a club of a different person.
- xi. A player needs to be present at a max. of 10 min before his practice round or the tournament round has started at the respective. Only the playing group needs to be allocated.

COVID-19: TRAVEL INFO

It is a player's responsibility to check any governmental restrictions in his home country or the country/state the player is planning on to play the tournament. Pro Golf Events or GJG cannot give any info on travel restrictions as these may differ from country to country. Please make sure to inform yourself thoroughly, before you start traveling, that you are aware of any restrictions or guidelines opposed by the government due to the threat by Covid 19.

COVID-19: IMPORTANT NEW REGISTRATION TOOL

In the past a player had to be present in the tournament office or sent an email to confirm his participation on the OFFICIAL PRACTICE ROUND DAY according to Tour Rule #18. This will be currently not more applicable due to the SAFETY/HYGIENE Protocol. There will instead be an ONLINE REGISTRATION tool in your *GJG player's account* (Login: <https://ssl.globaljuniorgolf.com/member/index.php?modul=member&lang=en>). Please check **3 DAYS** before the tournament in your players account under YOUR TOURNAMENTS. Here you will find the instructions to confirm participation. Please do not forget this process otherwise you will NOT be listed in the tournament. An automatic confirmation email will be sent to your account email, confirming once you have finished the process accordingly.

1.0 Schedule and Format

This 54 hole individual championship takes place at the Rondebosch Golf Club (for course information visit <http://www.rondeboschgolfclub.com>). There are 18 holes played per day – morning only. The NOMADS SAJI will be held from 8 - 10 March 2022. Official practice round is on March 7th 2022.

2.0 Eligibility to play

This event is co-sanctioned between the GJG Tour and 21golffleague and is open to amateur golfers, both boys and girls, in the age classes:

2.1 GJG Tour players age 12-18 (max. 18 at the start of the event – March 4th 2022)

2.2 21golffleague age 19-21 (max. 21 at the start of the event)

- > All players need to become a GJG Tour member or 21golffleague member
- > All players must be members of a registered golf club
- > Handicap limit: Boys 5 / Girls 7 (for South African players: HCP Index Boys 2 / Girls 5)

2.3 Teeing areas

- > All girls will play from red tees
- > All boys from yellow tees

If a player does not meet the HCP limits or has no GJG eligibility status, please send a wildcard inquiry to service@globaljuniorgolf.com with latest tournament results. The tournament committee has 10 wildcards available.

3.0 Field Size

The tournament is open for a maximum of 120 participants (minimum 45 spots are reserved for internationals). The tournament committee reserves the right to change/limit the size of the field. One third of the field will be designated for girls. If the field is limited, the tournament committee shall apply the following guidelines in determining which entries shall be accepted:

- 3.1 Handicap;
- 3.2 National event finishes;
- 3.3 International and National Ranking Systems;
- 3.4 Tournament Committee Invitations.

4.0 Entry: Closing Date and Procedures

4.1 International Players

Entries close on February 7th 2022 and confirmation is given out by first come first serve.

All international players must be or become a member of the Global Junior Golf on the terms and conditions as determined by the GJG. International entries register directly on the <https://www.globaljuniorgolf.com/register/> web site.

International players may request early confirmation of entry to help with international travel bookings directly from the organizer Pro Golf Events. A player is only accepted at the tournament, if he has paid in full the Entry Fee towards Pro Golf Events.

4.2 South African Nationals

Entries close on February 7th 2022.

South African players must ONLY register on South African entry form and abide by the conditions relating to South African players only. Please read exemption criteria and the entry conditions and information for South African Nationals on the South African Nationals Entry Form.

4.3 Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the tournament committee.

> All information required in the entry form must be provided accurately and in full.

5.0 Prizes

On conclusion of 54 holes:

5.1 The winner of the Boys Competition will be awarded the Boys Champion Trophy. Prizes will also be awarded to the players finishing from 1st to 3rd place.

5.2 The winner of the Girls Competition will be awarded the Girls Champion Trophy. Prizes will also be awarded to the players finishing from 1st to 3rd place.

5.3 International Team Competition trophy will be awarded to the winning team as well as a prize for each member of the winning team.

It is compulsory for all players to attend prize giving which will take place immediately after completion of the final round - around 02:00 PM on March 10th 2022.

6.0 ONLINE REGISTRATION - MANDATORY

There will be no registration on site!: In the past a player had to be present in the tournament office or sent an email to confirm his participation on the OFFICIAL PRACTICE ROUND DAY according to Tour Rule #18. This will be currently not available due to the SAFETY/HYGIENE Protocol. There will be instead an ONLINE REGISTRATION tool in your GJG players account. Please check 3DAYS before the tournament in your players account under YOUR TOURNAMENTS. Here you will find the instructions to confirm participation. Please do not forget this process otherwise you will NOT be listed in the tournament. An automatic confirmation email will be sent to your account email, confirming once you have finished the process accordingly. HOW TO LOG IN TO YOUR ACCOUNT? Please go to the Global Junior Golf Website and click on the top of the page LOGIN. In case you don't have your password, please use LOST PASSWORD and put in the email you have used as players email. Make sure to check your spam and it may take a few minutes! Once you have your login details, please login and proceed with the online confirmation und the section YOUR TOURNAMENTS!

7.0 Practice Rounds & Trolleys

The official tournament practice round is Monday March 7th 2022. (07:30 AM to 01:00 PM) To book an official practice time please send an email to golfmanager@rgc.co.za. All official practice times booked will be allocated on a first come first served basis. These times are open only for players participating in the tournament. Only limited Trolleys are available and have to be booked directly at the golf course. Please send your email to: golfmanager@rgc.co.za well in advance.

8.0 Entry Fee

INTERNATIONALS € 180

The Entry Fee has to be paid to the organizer Pro Golf Events and includes:

- Official practice round
- Tournament rounds
- Use of the practice facilities
- Fruit and drinks on the golf course during the tournament

9.0 Accommodation Recommendation (not mandatory)

10.0 Rules of Golf and Close of Competition

The tournament will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, the actual rules of the South African Golf Federation approved by the tournament committee and the GJG Hard Card. The Local Rules will be published and posted on the tournament notice board at the venue. The competition is deemed to be closed when the trophy has been presented. Play will not be extended beyond Thursday 10th March 2022. Furthermore player have to comply with the Tour Rules of Global Junior Golf: <https://www.globaljuniorgolf.com/tour-rules/>
